

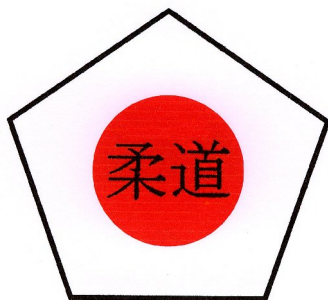

Family Discount: For any family with three or more competitors entering, a discount of £1.00 per competitor will be levied. **(only applies to pre booked entries)** ** (Please note: Family discount is subject to terms and conditions)

Categories (Kgs)

Under 5th Kyu Juniors: Competitors will be divided into groups of four dependent on size and gender

Juniors: Boys: U21, U24, U27, U30, U34, U38, U42, U46, U50, U55, U60, U66, O66

Girls: U19, U22, U25, U28, U32, U36, U40, U44, U48, U52, U57, O57

Intermediates: Male: U55, U60, U66, U73, U81, U90, O90

Female: U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, U78, O78

Seniors: Male: U60, U66, U73, U81, U90, U100, O100

Female: U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, U78, O78

Notes: Under 5th Kyu, all competitors will receive a medal
Under 5th Kyu Competitors need to be on the mat no later than 10.00am so they can be placed into their contest groups.
The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate categories as required.
Weigh in: All male competitors must wear at least Judogi trousers, females at least Judogi trousers & 'T-shirt. Contestants weighing in at the exact weight will be considered to be the weight group above (i.e. if you weigh in at 21 kgs you will contest the U24 Kgs group)

Please complete and return the attached Entry form, together with the appropriate fee, to be received no later than 10th April 2009

Entry is restricted to current British Judo Council (MAC) members. Licenses will be inspected on entry. Proof of age may be required for juniors and intermediates.

** Family Discount will only apply if all three or more entries are placed at the same time and only applies to pre booked entries. All entries must be for close family (i.e. sons, daughters, brothers and sisters only). To apply for Family Discount mark the appropriate space on the entry form. The organisers reserve the right to refuse Family Discount if the above conditions are not met.

Any player who holds a grade from any other association which is higher than their BJC(MAC) grade, must wear a belt to the appropriate grade.

Junior Competitors are classed as those who are under 16 years of age on the day of the event.

Intermediate Competitors are classed as those who are between the ages of 16—and are under 18 years of age on the day of the event

Senior competitors are those who are 18 years of age and over on the day of the event.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel / amalgamate weight groups as required.

Current British Judo Council (MAC) contest rules will apply:-

Arm locks, Strangles and Sacrificial Throws for under 5th kyu juniors will not be allowed.

Arm locks & Strangles will not be allowed for juniors.

There will be NO coaching from the side of the mat.

Clubs / Parents are reminded that all children must be under responsible adult supervision at all times.

Any children caught running around the centre will be asked to leave. This may also mean that you or your club will not be invited to future events.

The organisers \ sports centre reserve the right to refuse entry without assigning reason.

The organisers \ sports centre will not be held responsible for any injury to person or for any loss \ damage to property howsoever caused.

Referees, Timekeepers and Recorders please note that you may only be required for two hours at a time and that refreshments will be supplied.

Entries to be submitted on the official entry form (photocopies will be accepted) and should be accompanied by the appropriate fee, to be received by the entry co-ordinator no later than 10th April 2009. Note all entries received after this date will not be processed and will be subject to on the day fees.

Cancellation of entry will be allowed with a full refund up to the close of entry date (applications for a refund must be received in writing before 10th April 2009). After this date no refund of entry fee will be possible. (proof of exceptional circumstances will be considered on individual basis).
