Categories (Kgs)

Under 5th Kyu

Competitors will be divided into groups of four dependent on size and gender

Juniors: Boys: U21, U24, U27, U30, U34, U38, U42, U46, U50, U55, U60, U66, U73,
U81, O81

Girls: U19, U22, U25, U28, U32, U36, U40, U44, U48, U52, U57, U63, O63

Intermediates: Male: U55, U60, U66, U73, U81, U90, U100.

Female: U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, U78, O78

Seniors: Male: U60, U66, U73, U81, U90, U100, O100

Female: U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, U78, O78

Notes: Under 5th Kyu, all competitors will receive a medal

Under 5th Kyu Competitors need to be on the mat no later than 10.00am so they can be placed into their contest groups.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate categories as required. Intermediates and Seniors may also be amalgamated depending on Numbers.

Weigh in: All male competitors must wear at least Judogi trousers, females at least Judogi trousers & 'T-shirt. Contestants weighing in at the exact weight will be considered to be the weight group above (i.e. boys weighing in at 21 kgs you will contest in the U24 Kgs group)

Please complete and return the attached Entry form, together with the appropriate fee, to be received no later than 18th May 2009.

Entry is restricted to current license holders of the BJC(MAC), BJA, BJC, AJA & AEJF. Licenses will be inspected on entry. Proof of age may be required for juniors and Intermediates.

Any player, who holds a grade from any other association which is higher than their BJC (MAC) grade, must wear the higher grade.

Junior Competitors are classed as those who are under 16 years of age on the day of the event.

Intermediate Competitors are classed as those who are between the ages of 16—18 years of age on the day of the event. Depending on Numbers the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate intermediates and Senior weight groups.

Senior competitors are those who are over 18 years of age.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel / amalgamate weight groups as required. Current British Judo Council (MAC) contest rules will apply:-

Arm locks, Strangles and Sacrificial Throws for under 5th kyu juniors will not be allowed.

Arm locks & Strangles will not be allowed for juniors.

There will be NO coaching from the side of the mat.

Clubs / Parents are reminded that all children must be under responsible adult supervision at all times.

Any children caught running around the centre will be asked to leave. This may also mean that you or your club will not be invited to future events.

The organiser's \ sports centre reserve the right to refuse entry without assigning reason.

The organiser's \ sports centre will not be held responsible for any injury to person or for any loss \ damage to property howsoever caused.

Photographic and Video Imagery will be allowed at this Event and may find its way into the public forum to promote the Sport of Judo. The organisers of the event take no responsibility for policing any material taken during this event. Anybody objecting to this is advised not to attend.

Referees, Timekeepers and Recorders please note that you may only be required for two hours at a time and that refreshments will be supplied.

Entries to be submitted on the official entry form (photocopies will be accepted) and should be accompanied by the appropriate fee, to be received by the entry coordinator no later than 18th May 2009. Note all entries received after this date will not be processed and will be subject to on the day fees.

Cancellation of entry will be allowed with a full refund up to the close of entry date (applications for a refund must be received in writing before 18th May 2009). After this date no refund of entry fee will be possible. (Proof of exceptional circumstances will be considered on individual basis).
